All work needs to be completed and turned in by Thursday, May 28.

### **Kindergarten to Grade 11:**

The final day of instruction for students in kindergarten through eleventh grade will be Friday, May 29. From Monday, June 1 to Thursday, June 4, faculty will work with students who still need to submit outstanding work prior to the finalization of grades for the fourth grading period.
