ALL WORK MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE KEYSTONE SCHOOL BY AUGUST 1. Work submitted beyond August 1 will **NOT** be accepted South Park High School.

All courses must be approved by your guidance counselor or principal prior to enrollment. This will ensure that you will be able to earn credit for any courses taken. Each institution has a different grading scale; however, South Park School District requires students to follow its grading scale and obtain a minimum of a 65% to pass each course taken.
