SOUTH PARK MIDDLE SCHOOL 2021-2022 FAMILY GUIDE

STUDENT SCHEDULES

Middle school student schedules will be available in PowerSchool beginning on Wednesday, August 18, 2021. Students in fifth grade and new students will receive a copy of their schedule at orientation. New transfer students will also receive information about how to set up their PowerSchool and Parent Portal accounts at orientation. South Park administrators and staff are still making adjustments to schedules, so they are subject to change.

Families will notice several changes to the format of the middle school schedules this year. There is no longer a six-day rotation at South Park Middle School. Rather, electives for students in fifth and sixth grades will run on a 30-day rotation, including physical education time. Students in seventh and eighth grades will have a semester of physical education, a quarter of health and a quarter of real-world applications (career readiness). They will also have two, one-semester electives that they filled out last school year.

All students will be scheduled for Eagle Time at the end of the school day. This time is for students to organize their materials, begin to complete any out-of-class work and receive teacher support for their classes.

Students will also be scheduled for WIN (What I Need) Time, which is designed to give students a time for enrichment, remediation and support.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Middle school students may arrive no earlier than 7:50 a.m. Car-rider drop-off will be from 7:50-8 a.m. in the back of the building (same area as last year). Any student arriving after 8 a.m. must report to the office. All students must be in their homeroom by 8:05 a.m.

Car-rider pick-up will also be conducted in the back of the building. Parents/guardians may arrive any time from 2:50-3 p.m. Dismissal is at 2:57 p.m. The middle school will once again use a number-based pick-up system for pick-up. Numbers will be distributed to car-riders at the beginning of the year.





HOMEROOMS

South Park Middle School students are to be in their homerooms by 8:05 a.m. A middle school student's homeroom is his/her first period class, which can be found on the student's schedule in PowerSchool.



LUNCH

All middle school students will eat in the cafeteria. There are four lunch periods, one for each grade level.

In the 2021-2022 school year, all students may receive one (1) free breakfast and one (1) free lunch per school day. Students must pay for any additional meals and all a la carte items.
