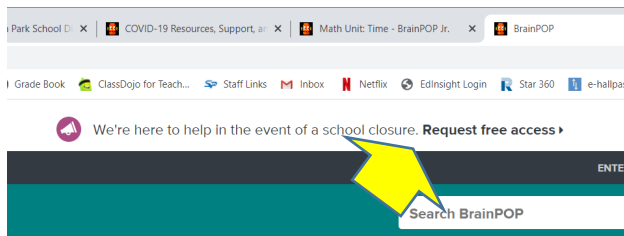
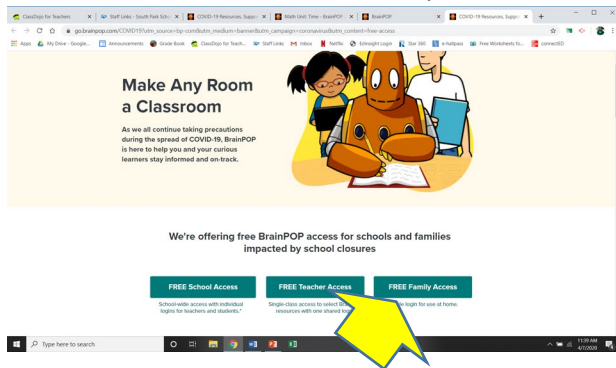


OPTIONAL Brain Pop Jr. Activities for Reading and Math Directions

2. Click on Free Access



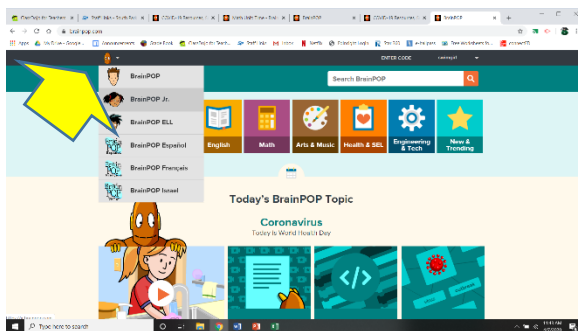
3. Scroll down and click on Free Family Access
