STUDENT SCHEDULES

High school student schedules will be available in PowerSchool beginning on Wednesday, August 18, 2021. Students in ninth grade and new students will receive a copy of their schedule at orientation. New transfer students will also receive information about how to set up their PowerSchool and Parent Portal accounts at orientation.

Schedules will only be changed in a small number of scenarios. All schedule change requests must be submitted using this online form. Counselors will contact students via email once the schedule change request is reviewed/completed, so please have your child frequently check his/her district email.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

High school students may arrive no earlier than 7:05 a.m. All high school students must be in their assigned homeroom by 7:25 a.m. or they will be marked tardy. Dismissal at South Park High School is at 2:20 p.m.

Car-riders may be dropped off in the morning and picked up in the afternoon at Door 32, which is on the side of the building closest to Brownsville Road. Please drive cautiously on our campus.





SCHOOL DAY REMINDERS

All students are encouraged to bring reusable water bottles to use at water bottle refill stations. Single-use plastic bottles cannot be used at these stations. Also, locker use has been reinstated for the school year.





HOMEROOMS

South Park High School will return to its previous homeroom procedures for the 2021-2022 school year. This means, all students will report to the homeroom listed on their schedules. Homeroom will no longer be in a student's first period class.



LUNCH

All high school students will eat in the cafeteria this year. When students report to the cafeteria, they are to be seated. They will then be called table-by-table to the lunch line.

In the 2021-2022 school year, all students may receive one (1) free breakfast and one (1) free lunch per school day. Students must pay for any additional meals and all a la carte items.
